

1. ROYAL PALACE

The Royal Palace of Cambodia is a complex of buildings which serves as the official royal residence of the King of Cambodia. Its full name in Khmer is the Preah Barom Reacheaveang Chaktomuk Serey Mongkol.

Note: Exposed shoulders and backs are forbidden, visitors must wear dresses or shorts below the knee.



The National Museum of Cambodia is home to the world's finest collection of Khmer sculpture: a millennium's worth and more of masterful Khmer design. Its collection includes over 14,000 items, from prehistoric times to periods before, during and after the Khmer Empire,

The National Museum of Cambodia works to preserve and promote Cambodian cultural heritages and traditions. Apart from that, the Museum also functions as a religious site for Cambodian people.



3. TUOL SLENG GENOCIDE MUSEUM

Entrance Fee 5USD Adults | 3USD for children



The Tuol Sleng Genocide Museum is the memorial site of the S-21 interrogation and detention center of the Khmer Rouge regime where at least 12,273 people were tortured and executed. The Khmer Rouge meticulously kept records of each person that arrived at the detention centre, and throughout, you'll see photos of victims, men, women and children.

It's worth hiring a guide, as they can tell you the stories behind some of the people in the photographs. An audio tour is also available, and recommended for greater insight for visitors without a guide.

4. THE KILLING FIELD (CHOEUNG EK)

Entrance Fee 6USD Per Pax



The Killing Fields are a number of sites in Cambodia where collectively more than 1,000,000 people were killed and buried by the Communist Party of Kampuchea during Khmer Rouge rule of the country from 1975 to 1979. After many prisoners were initially killed at S-21, the site Choeung Ek outside of the city was later chosen as a more appropriate site for mass execution.

Today, Choeung Ek is a memorial, marked by a Buddhist stupa. The stupa has acrylic glass sides and is filled with over 5,000 human skulls.






5. SUNSET ON RIVER
